HYF Dance is dedicated to giving dancers in school years 5 and above the opportunity to dance on a real stage with professional technical support at the Kenton Theatre.

Who can enter?

HYF Dance is for solo, pairs or small groups of dancers in school years 5 and above.

Anyone within this age group is eligible to enter if you attend or live in the catchment area for one of the following participating schools: Badgemore; Bishopswood; Gillotts; Kidmore End; Nettlebed; Peppard; Sacred Heart; Shiplake; Sonning Common; Trinity; Valley Road, OR attend St Mary's or Rupert House, Henley College; Shiplake College or Chiltern Edge.

There is a **separate Young Dancer** event for younger dancers in **school years 1 - 4** on **Saturday 16 March at 1pm**. In the event of HYF Dance being oversubscribed, HYF reserves the right to move Yr 5/6 entrants to the Young Dancer event.

If you are entering as a group please enter the event appropriate for the oldest member.

Can I enter as a soloist AND as part of a group?

You may, but you can only take part in 2 items in total. Please fill in a separate entry form for each. If the event is oversubscribed we may have to limit the total number of performances.

Can I choreograph my own dance?

Yes, we would prefer your own choreography but you may ask for guidance from an adult. If your dance contains elements of gymnastics please complete an entry form for the Entertain event.

Can my dance be based on the theme?

Yes if you would like it to be. This year's theme is **'Dreams'** and you may interpret this in any way you wish.

Can I use a backing track?

Yes you can. The Sound Engineer will require a copy of your chosen piece as soon as possible. This should be **emailed as an MP3/MP4 file** to **hyfinfo@gmail.com** by the closing date of **26 February 2019** with **the name of your act and 'HYF Dance'** in the subject box. If your backing track is longer than 3 minutes please record and fade your track to fit the time.

Can I use props?

Yes you can, but please limit to those that can easily be taken on and off stage and leave no mess!

How long should my performance be?

Your piece should be **3 minutes or under**.

Will there be rehearsals?

As with any professional performance you will be expected to come to the Kenton Theatre for a technical rehearsal, which will either take place on the day, or on the Sunday prior to the event – you will be contacted to arrange a time.

Will there be any feedback on my performance?

Special guests will be present and feedback guidance notes for all performers will be sent after the event.

What time do I need to arrive?

After you have sent in your entry form you will be contacted with all the details.

How do I buy tickets?

Tickets are available from the Kenton Box Office. **Max 4 per booking. Ticket Sales open Wednesday 27 February 2019.**
